## INSTRUCTIONS

### GIVING LIST

### WISHING LIST

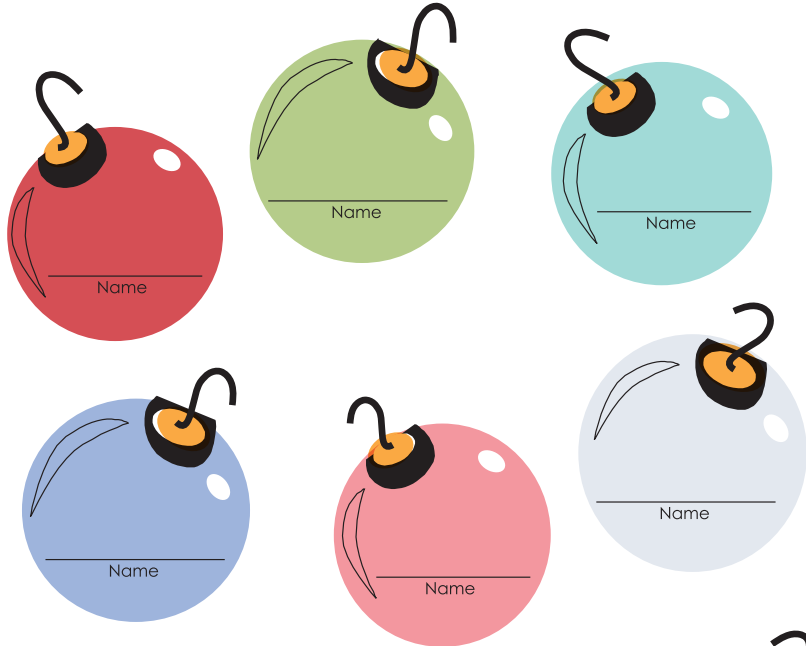
1. Fill in the Christmas presents on page 4 with the names of the gifts you would like to receive for Christmas.
