TWO Urban Licks

This wood-fired cuisine option has incredible skyline views while also offering outdoor eating for those needing a more fresh air experience. Need some music to go with your menu? Live blues music is available Wednesday-Saturday.

Little Alley Steakhouse

Atlanta Marriott Marquis
